RULES

Notice of withdrawal, should be given in writing by the parent one month in advance to be withdrawn from March and one month in advance to be withdrawn from November each year, if the child is withdrawn earlier the parent will have to pay fees for the entire academic session.

- 1. The Parent must give the Notice of withdrawal from the school bus in writing one month in advance during any month.
- Those leaving School in May must pay the fees for May and June (Summer). Those leaving in December must pay for December and January (Winter).
- 3. Fee must be paid on time; otherwise, a Late Fee Fine will be charged. If the fee remains unpaid for two months after the due date, the student's name is liable to be removed from the school rolls.
- 4. No Transfer Certificate will be issued until all dues to the School are paid.
- 5. Pupils must wear the prescribed school uniform (Summer/Winter). In this respect, a defaulter is liable to be debarred from class.
- 6. The Principal is empowered to rusticate or suspend or remove a pupil from the School's rolls on indiscipline, misbehaviour, gross neglect of academic work or frequent absence without prior Notice to the Parent.
- 7. The school management is not liable for any loss of property, damage/charges on account of injuries, fatal or otherwise, which may be sustained by the student at any time during his/her stay in the School, in the school bus or while taking part in sports, Co-curricular activities, picnics or in any other form of activities of the School within or outside the school premises.
- 8. Manhandling is strictly prohibited. Any student found guilty of indulging in manhandling is liable to be expelled from the School.
- 9. A student who fails for the 2nd time in his/her entire stay in Cambrian Hall will have to be withdrawn by the parents.
- 10. A student who fails in the ICSE/ISC class will not be re-admitted in the School in the same class.
- 11. In the case of eligible candidates who are being entered for the ICSE (Class 10) Examination, a minimum of 75% attendance of the working days during each year of the two-year course is mandatory, at Schools affiliated to the Council. Similarly, eligible candidates who are being entered for the ISC (Class12) Examination must have a minimum of 75% attendance of the working days during each year of the two-year course, at Schools affiliated to the Council.
- 12. Fee once deposited will not be refunded in any case.

BOARDERS

- Withdrawal of a boarder will be permitted only at the end of an academic session, i.e. December or May each year.
 Notice of withdrawal should be given six months in advance. Those withdrawn in the middle of an academic session will be charged full boarding lodging and tuition fees for the entire academic session (i.e. Six months).
- 2. If Parents would like to withdraw wards from the Boarding, they must submit the withdrawal application six months in advance to the Principal; otherwise, they will have to pay tuition fees, lodging and boarding charges for the full six months in lieu of notice.
- 3. Changes of status from a boarder to a day scholar during a term will not be permitted unless the parents are transferred to Dehradun and three months clear Notice is given in writing for such changes; otherwise, parents will have to pay three months' tuition fee and boarding charges in lieu of Notice. However, if a parent insists on changing status, the student will have to be withdrawn from the School.
- 4. Fees in arrears of one term, if not cleared before the commencement of the next term, will automatically debar the boarder from further retention in the hostel.
- Boarders are not allowed to bring items of clothing, jewellery, cosmetics or eatables other than what is permitted in the Prospectus or a circular from the Principal. The dorm in charge will check boxes with personal luggage when a boarder returns after summer/winter vacations.
- 6. Boarders who return late after a vacation or midterm break are liable to expulsion from the hostel. The Principal is empowered to remove a student from the hostel on indiscipline, misbehaviour, gross neglect of academic work, or regular absence without prior Notice to the Parent. If a boarder overstays leave without intimating the Principal, a fine of Rs. 1,000/- per day will be charged.
- 7. Ordinarily, boarders are not allowed to go home during the session except for exceptional reasons, explained in an application by the Parent (s) and with the approval of the Principal. Disregard of this rule may also be penalized by expulsion from the hostel.
