ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The minimum age of admission to the school, for day scholars in class Nursery is three years and not over four years as of 31st March and for boarders in class III is seven years and not over eight years as on 31st March. A student who is overage for a class will not be admitted.

The registration is open from 1st October to 31st January. The entrance examination is held on every Saturday followed by an interview for the students who qualify in the written examination.

Subjects for the written exam are as follows:

- a) Class I to III: English, Math, Hindi.
- b) Class IV to VIII: English, Hindi, Math and Science.
- c) Class IX- Science: English, Math and Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology).
- d) Class IX- Commerce: English and Math.

For classes Nursery, L.K.G. and U.K.G, admissions are determined by a round of interaction with the principal following registration.

The new academic session starts in the first week of April. No correspondence will be entertained in connection with the admission of students who do not qualify for the written examination.

Registration is open for classes I to IX. **No students are admitted to classes X and XII**. However, students from other schools are admitted to Class XI in July on the basis of their performance in Class X of a Board/State/University if vacancies are available. **The Principal has the sole right in regard to admission** and his decision will be final in this matter.

Admission is subject to the following conditions:

- a) Registration is between 1st October and 31st January each year (You can download the admission form <u>from above</u>).
- b) Number of vacancies in each class.
- c) Order of merit in the written examination and interview.

Parents must ensure that the Transfer Certificate issued to their child by the school meets the following requirements:

- a) The transfer certificate should be from a recognized school.
- c) The transfer certificate should be countersigned by the Inspector of Schools if the student is from another Board/outside Uttarakhand. In the absence of the above documents, the child will not be admitted to the school.
